

Your Health Care. Your Choice! Who is Your Health Care Agent?











Starting at 18 years old, you can choose a trusted person to be your Health Care Agent.

If you get sick and cannot make care decisions yourself, even for a short time while you get better, your Health Care Agent has the **power** to talk with your doctors and make decisions to get you the care you want. You appoint your Health Care Agent in a Health Care Proxy document.

Do it now so your Health Care Proxy is in place when you need it!



1. Choose a person you trust, like a family member, a friend, or anyone you like to be your Health Care Agent.



2. Print a free Health Care Proxy document. (In 15 languages.) Write in the name of your Health Care Agent and complete the form.
Make your own "I Have a Health Care Proxy" Wallet Card!



3. Give a copy of your Health Care Proxy to your doctors and care providers. They can call your Health Care Agent in an emergency.

What if I am not able to choose a Health Care Agent? No Agent? That's OK. You can write down what you want for care in a **Personal Directive (Living Will)** and share with your doctors.
